**Charter Amendment
Resolution No. 46**

RESOLUTION of the Mayor and City Council of Cumberland, Maryland, adopted pursuant to the authority contained in Article 11-E of the Constitution of the State of Maryland, and Section 13 of Article 23A of the Annotated Code of Maryland, entitled "Municipal Corporations," as said Section was enacted by Chapter 423 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, 1955, entitled "A RESOLUTION TO RESCIND CHARTER AMENDMENT RESOLUTION NO. 30 AND CHARTER AMENDMENT RESOLUTION NO. 31, SAID CHARTER AMENDMENT RESOLUTIONS HAVING BEEN FORMERLY ADOPTED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF CUMBERLAND."

Section 1. BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF CUMBERLAND, That Charter Amendment Resolutions Nos. 30 and 31, adopted respectively on February 12, 1968, and February 19, 1968, to provide the Mayor and City Council of Cumberland, under Section 81(b) of the City Charter, with the authority to levy and collect a tax on the assessable property of said City for the general purposes of said corporation, not exceeding in any one year One Dollar and Fifty Cents (\$1.50) on each One Hundred Dollars (\$100) worth of said assessable property, be and they are hereby rescinded.
