

warrant before any district court judge residing within the county, with the right of appeal to the accused to the circuit court for the county, such appeal to be taken within ten days from the date of conviction before the district court.

*19-20. Formulation, publication and enforcement of plumbing code.*

The county shall formulate, publish and enforce a plumbing code, and shall prescribe such rules and regulations governing the use of such water and water connections, and for the maintenance and operation of their systems, as they may deem necessary; and every person who shall make the personal service prescribed in Section 19-19 of this Code shall deliver to the person upon whom such service is made a copy of such plumbing code and of such rules and regulations, and shall obtain from such person upon whom such service is made a receipt of such copies, or in default of such receipt shall file with the county an affidavit that such copies have been delivered. Any violation of such plumbing code or of any rule or regulation prescribed by the county upon the part of any person to whom such copies shall have been delivered, shall be punishable by a fine not exceeding one hundred dollars, upon conviction before any district court judge, residing within the county.

*19-21. Notice to connect toilets and drains—Service.*

This notice to connect toilets and drains provided for in Section 19-19 of this Code shall be left with the owner or occupier, or agent of the property mentioned in such notice, and if there be no owner or occupier, or agent of the owner of such property, upon which such notice can be served, notice shall be deemed in all respects sufficient, if exposed in some open way upon the property to which it refers.

*19-22. Same—Duty of owner upon receipt.*

After receiving the notice to connect toilets and drains provided for in Section 19-19 of this Code, and within the time stated in such notice, the owner of all such property shall comply with the terms and requirements of such notice, and shall make the connection with the sewerage system, and do all of the things prescribed by such notice, in a thorough and workmanlike manner, and in faithful conformity with all existing laws, rules or regulations relating to plumbing, and especially so that no water from roofs or cellars or ground water will enter such portion of the sewerage system and shall also fill in all cesspools cleaned out pursuant to the notice with good, purse materials, and in cases where the old drain is to cross a cesspool in order to reach the new sewers, shall lay an iron instead of a vitrified pipe across such cesspool.

*19-23. Inspection of work by director.*

Before the work provided for in Sections 19-19 of this Code shall be covered up or put in operation, the work must be approved by the director of the sanitary district or his representative. Any violation of the provisions of this section shall subject the offender to a penalty of not less than twenty dollars nor more than one hundred dollars, to be collected as other fines are collected.
