**Resolution amending Section 22 of the Charter of
the Town of Elkton relative to Election Dates;
filing of Candidates, and terms of office**

Resolution of the Mayor and Commissioners of the Town of Elkton, adopted pursuant to the authority of Article 11E of the Constitution of Maryland, and Section 13 of Article 23A of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1957 Edition), title "Corporations—Municipal" as said section was enacted by Chapter 423 of the Laws of Maryland of 1955, to add a new section to the Code of the Public Local Laws of Cecil County of 1953, said new section to be known as Section 22, and constituting an amendment to the municipal charter of the body politic and corporate known as the Mayor and Commissioners of the Town of Elkton, said new section to change election dates, filing of candidates, and terms of office.

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 13 of Article 23A of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1957 Edition) the Mayor and Commissioners of the Town of Elkton are desirous of amending Section 22 of the charter of the Town of Elkton relating to election dates, filing of candidates, and terms of office.

Section 1. BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Commissioners of the Town of Elkton, that Section 22 of the charter of the Town of Elkton be and it is hereby amended to read as follows :

Section 22 (a)—On the fourth Monday of May starting with the year 1971, duly registered voters shall elect a Mayor who shall serve for a term of three years and until his successor is duly elected and qualified. At the end of this term all following terms shall be for four years and until his successor is duly elected and qualified.

(b) On the fourth Monday in May starting with the year 1971, the duly registered voters shall elect by ballot two Commissioners who shall serve for a term of three years and until their successors are duly elected and qualified. At the end of this term the following terms shall be for four year periods and until their successors are duly elected and qualified.
