one thousand six hundred and fifty-four decimal five, five (1,654.55) feet to a point on the northerly right of way line of North Park Drive Extended; thence along said right of way line South six degrees thirty-four minutes forty-eight seconds East eight hundred and fifty-five decimal zero, three (855.03) feet.

Section 2. AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, That said Resolution No. 127 be amended by inserting in lieu of the description deleted by Section 1 hereof, the following:

seven hundred and sixty-nine decimal eight, seven (769.87) feet to a point south of Beaglin Park Drive; thence South eighty degrees thirty-two minutes zero seconds West five hundred and eighteen decimal one, eight (518.18) feet to a point inside the fork of the road formed by Beaglin Park Drive and North Park Drive; thence South eighteen degrees twenty-two minutes fifty-eight seconds West two hundred and fifty decimal zero, two (250.02) feet to a point on the easterly right-of-way-line of North Park Drive Extended; thence along said right-of-way-line South six degrees thirty-four minutes forty-eight seconds East one thousand three hundred and thirty-six decimal two, six (1,336.26) feet.

Section 3. AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, That this resolution shall take effect on the effective date of said Resolution No. 127 and in all other respects Resolution No. 127 is hereby ratified and confirmed.
