

(B) THE CLERKS OF THE CIRCUIT COURTS OF THE COUNTIES AND THE CLERK OF THE COURT OF COMMON PLEAS OF BALTIMORE CITY SHALL TRANSMIT TO THE DEPARTMENT ON THE FIRST DAY OF EACH MONTH ALL MONEYS RECEIVED BY THEM FOR SPORT FISHING LICENSES AND STAMPS. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ACCOUNT FOR THESE FUNDS TO THE TREASURER WHO THEN SHALL CREDIT AMOUNTS RECEIVED TO THE STATE FISHERIES MANAGEMENT AND PROTECTION FUND. THE TREASURER SHALL PAY OUT FUNDS ON THE WARRANT OF THE COMPTROLLER UPON REQUISITION OF THE DEPARTMENT.

(C) ONE THIRD OF THE FUNDS CREDITED TO THE STATE GAME PROTECTION FUND AS OF JULY 1, 1973, SHALL BE CREDITED TO THE STATE FISHERIES MANAGEMENT AND PROTECTION FUND.

125B.

(A) THE STATE WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT AND PROTECTION FUND IS CREATED WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES. ANY MONEY ACCRUING TO THE FUND FROM HUNTING LICENSE AND STAMP FEES SHALL BE CREDITED TO THIS FUND AND USED ONLY FOR THE SCIENTIFIC INVESTIGATION, PROTECTION, PROPAGATION, AND MANAGEMENT OF WILDLIFE.

(B) THE CLERKS OF THE CIRCUIT COURTS OF THE COUNTIES AND THE CLERK OF THE COURT OF COMMON PLEAS OF BALTIMORE CITY SHALL TRANSMIT TO THE DEPARTMENT ON THE FIRST DAY OF EACH MONTH ALL MONEYS RECEIVED BY THEM FOR HUNTING LICENSES AND STAMPS. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ACCOUNT FOR THESE FUNDS TO THE TREASURER WHO THEN SHALL CREDIT AMOUNTS RECEIVED TO THE STATE WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT AND PROTECTION FUND. THE TREASURER SHALL PAY OUT FUNDS ON THE WARRANT OF THE COMPTROLLER UPON REQUISITION OF THE DEPARTMENT.

(C) TWO THIRDS OF THE FUNDS CREDITED TO THE STATE GAME PROTECTION FUND AS OF JULY 1, 1973, SHALL BE TRANSFERRED TO THE STATE WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT AND PROTECTION FUND.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1973.

CHAPTER 803

(House Bill 782)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 163(j) of Article 2B of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1968 Replacement Volume and 1972 Supplement), title "Alcoholic Beverages," subtitle "County Liquor Control Boards and Dispensaries," making the appointed manager of dispensaries in Kent County hold office at the pleasure of the County Commissioners.
