

9-309. PAYMENT OF COURT COSTS BY STATE.

THE COURT MAY ORDER THE STATE TO PAY COURT COSTS OF ANY APPEAL IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF §§9-304, 9-305, OR 9-308 IF IT FINDS THAT THE FINANCIAL SITUATION OF THE PERSON APPEALING WARRANTS THIS ACTION.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section presently appears as Article 66C, section 729 of the Code. The only changes made are in style.

9-310. COURTS TO RESTRAIN VIOLATIONS OF SUBTITLE.

THE COURT EXERCISING EQUITY JURISDICTION IN THE COUNTY WHERE THE LAND OR ANY PART OF THE LAND IS LOCATED MAY RESTRAIN ANY VIOLATION OF THIS SUBTITLE IN AN ACTION BROUGHT BY THE DEPARTMENT OR ANY AUTHORIZED UNIT OR OFFICER OF THE DEPARTMENT.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived from the final sentence of Article 66C, section 730 of the Code. "County" includes Baltimore City; Article 1, section 14. The Superior Court of Baltimore City, which is given jurisdiction under the present law, does not normally exercise equity jurisdiction. As the section is revised, jurisdiction is vested in the circuit court for a county or the Circuit Court or Circuit Court No. 2 in Baltimore.

SUBTITLE 4. LANDS FORMED BY CHANNEL EXCAVATION IN SINEPUXENT, ISLE OF WIGHT, AND CHINCOTEAGUE BAYS.

9-401. CONSTRUCTION OF SUBTITLE.

THIS SUBTITLE DOES NOT AFFECT ANY PAST OR FUTURE ACCRETION TO LAND UNDER PRIVATE OWNERSHIP BOUNDING ON, OR SURROUNDED BY THE WATERS OF THE CHINCOTEAGUE, ISLE OF WIGHT, OR SINEPUXENT BAY.
