

DUPLICATE LICENSE IN A LEGIBLE AND PROPER MANNER AND SUBMIT ANY NECESSARY REPORT OF SALE TOGETHER WITH THE DUPLICATE LICENSE AFTER THE FIRST DAY OF EACH MONTH AS LONG AS HE SELLS THESE LICENSES IN ACCORDANCE WITH §10-301. THE REPORT AND DUPLICATE LICENSES SHALL REACH THE DEPARTMENT BY THE SEVENTH DAY OF EACH SUCCEEDING MONTH. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL REIMBURSE ANY AGENT THE SUM PAID FOR UNISSUED HUNTER'S LICENSE PROVIDED THEY ARE RETURNED INTACT, AND STILL ATTACHED IN THE ISSUING BOOKS BY JUNE 30 OF EACH YEAR, AND HAVE BEEN CHECKED AND FOUND TO BE CORRECT BY THE DEPARTMENT. EVERY LICENSE NOT RETURNED BY JUNE 30 SHALL BE DEEMED SOLD AND NOT REIMBURSABLE UNLESS ACCOMPANIED BY A STATEMENT UNDER OATH STATING WHY THE LICENSE IS RETURNED LATE. THE DEPARTMENT, AFTER REVIEW, MAY REIMBURSE THE AGENT.

(D) FALSE STATEMENT. - A DESIGNATED PERSON MAY NOT MAKE ANY FALSE STATEMENT CONCERNING ANY DATE OF ISSUANCE OR OTHER LICENSE DATA. EVERY LICENSE BOOK OR DUPLICATE LICENSE SHALL BE AVAILABLE FOR ANY LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER TO INSPECT AT ANY TIME DURING THE REGULAR BUSINESS DAY. AN AGENT MAY NOT ISSUE ANY LICENSE WITHOUT RECEIVING LICENSE FEES REQUIRED BY LAW. A RECEIPT MAY NOT BE ISSUED IN LIEU OF A HUNTER'S LICENSE.

(E) LOSS OF LICENSE ISSUING PRIVILEGE. - IN ADDITION TO ANY OTHER PENALTY PROVIDED FOR BY THE PROVISIONS OF THIS TITLE, ANY AGENT CONVICTED OF VIOLATING THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION SHALL HAVE HIS HUNTER'S LICENSE ISSUING PRIVILEGE RESCINDED.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section presently appears as Article 66C, section 129(h) of the Code. This section has been reorganized and divided into subsections for clarity. The reference to "hunting" license is proposed for deletion and the appropriate nomenclature is substituted therefor.

Subsection (t) is new language added to indicate that licenses less than those already compiled in book form may not be distributed. The present reference to county resident licenses is proposed for deletion since the county license provision was abolished by Chapter 103, Acts of 1972. Minimum limits for age related licenses also are set forth because these licenses are also included in the ticket books.
