

BARTER, OR EXCHANGE ANY MIGRATORY GAME BIRD EXCEPT AS PROVIDED BY FEDERAL OR STATE LAWS AND RULES AND REGULATIONS.

(B) HUNTING AND POSSESSING WILD WATERFOWL IN EXCESS OF FEDERAL AND STATE LIMITS PROHIBITED. - A PERSON MAY NOT HUNT OR POSSESS ANY MIGRATORY GAME BIRD IN EXCESS OF THE LIMITS PRESCRIBED BY FEDERAL OR STATE LAWS AND RULES AND REGULATIONS.

(C) HUNTING ON FEDERAL OR STATE MIGRATORY BIRD REFUGES. - A PERSON MAY NOT HUNT MIGRATORY GAME BIRDS AT ANY TIME OR IN ANY MANNER ON LAND OR IN WATERS WITHIN THE BOUNDARY LINES OF ANY FEDERAL OR STATE OWNED OR CONTROLLED MIGRATORY BIRD REFUGE UNLESS PERMITTED BY FEDERAL OR STATE LAWS OR RULES AND REGULATIONS.

REVISOR'S NOTE: Subsection (a) presently appears as Article 66C, section 150(b), and subsection (b) appears as section 150(c). Although subsection (a) duplicates somewhat proposed section 10-402(c), it prohibits buying, unlike 10-402(c), and is retained to emphasize that federal rules regulate this area as well as State law.

Subsection (c) presently appears as Article 66C, section 150(d) of the Code.

The only other changes made are in style.

10-404. HUNTING, POSSESSING, AND SELLING GAME BIRDS OR MAMMALS.

(A) HUNTING OR POSSESSING GAME BIRDS OR MAMMALS DURING CLOSED SEASON PROHIBITED. - A PERSON MAY NOT HUNT OR ATTEMPT TO HUNT ANY GAME BIRD OR MAMMAL EXCEPT DURING OPEN SEASON, OR POSSESS ANY DEAD GAME BIRD OR MAMMAL DURING ANY CLOSED SEASON WHETHER HUNTED IN THE STATE OR IN ANOTHER STATE, TERRITORY, OR COUNTRY. HOWEVER, A PERSON MAY POSSESS ANY DEAD GAME BIRD OR MAMMAL FOR FIVE DAYS AND DEER FOR 30 DAYS AFTER THE SEASON CLOSES FOR USE AS FOOD. ALSO, A LICENSED HUNTER MAY OBTAIN A PERMIT FROM THE DEPARTMENT DURING OPEN SEASON OR WITHIN FIVE DAYS AFTER OPEN SEASON CLOSES TO POSSESS ANY FROZEN GAME BIRD OR MAMMAL FOR A PERIOD NOT EXCEEDING 180 DAYS.

(B) GAME BIRDS OR MAMMALS IMPORTED DURING CLOSED SEASON. - A PERSON MAY SHIP OR BRING INTO THE STATE BY
