

(C) SINGLE-SERVICE OR MASS-PRODUCED ITEMS.

THE SECRETARY MAY TEST WITH REPRESENTATIVE SAMPLES ANY SINGLE-SERVICE DEVICE OR MASS-PRODUCED DEVICE. THE LOT OF WHICH ANY SAMPLE IS REPRESENTATIVE SHALL BE HELD TO BE CORRECT OR INCORRECT UPON THE BASIS OF THE RESULTS OF THE INSPECTIONS AND TESTS ON THE SAMPLES. FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, A SINGLE-SERVICE DEVICE IS A DEVICE DESIGNED TO BE USED COMMERCIALY ONLY ONCE AND THEN DISCARDED; AND A MASS-PRODUCED DEVICE IS A DEVICE PRODUCED BY MEANS OF A MOLD OR DIE AND NOT SUSCEPTIBLE OF INDIVIDUAL ADJUSTMENT.

REVISOR'S NOTE: Subsection (a) is new language derived from the third sentence of Art. 97, §9 of the Code. Subsection (b) presently appears as the first two sentences of Art. 97, §9 of the Code.

Subsection (c) presently appears as the fourth sentence of Art. 97, §9 of the Code.

The remaining provisions of Art. 97, §9 are proposed for deletion because they appear as new language in §§ 11-205(b) and 11-211.

SEC. 11-210. SECRETARY TO TEST STANDARDS USED BY SERVICEMEN OF SERVICE AGENCIES.

THE SECRETARY SHALL TEST THE STANDARDS OF WEIGHTS AND MEASURES AND OTHER APPROPRIATE EQUIPMENT POSSESSED AND USED BY ANY SERVICEMAN AND ANY SERVICE AGENCY ENGAGED IN THE MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR OF WEIGHING AND MEASURING DEVICES. HE SHALL CHARGE REASONABLE TESTING FEES.
