MESSAGE FROM THE SENATE

Senate Bill No. 10—By Senator James:

AN ACT concerning

Governor—Executive and Administrative Departments

FOR the purpose of prohibiting the adoption or amendment of rules and administrative actions which increase the expenditures of an agency beyond budgetary allowance, without the approval of the General Assembly or its presiding officers under certain circumstances, with an exception, and to make this prohibition applicable to all agencies.

AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 15

By the Committee on Constitutional and Administrative Law:

Amendment No. 1—

In line 3 of the title on page 1 of the first reader, immediately before the word "disclosure", insert the word "periodic"; and in line 10 strike the word "requesting" and insert in lieu thereof the word "directing"; and in line 14, immediately after the word "officials," insert the following: "authorizing the Governor to extend by Executive Order certain disclosure requirements to certain appointed persons,".
