

MONEYS UNDER THIS SECTION, THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL HAVE THE SAME AUTHORITY TO ENTER INTO CONTRACTS ON BEHALF OF THE STATE AS IS GRANTED TO THE ADMINISTRATION UNDER § 7-702(C) OF THIS ARTICLE WITH RESPECT TO FEDERAL MONEYS ACCEPTED ON BEHALF OF MUNICIPALITIES. ALL MONEYS RECEIVED BY THE ADMINISTRATION PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION SHALL BE DEPOSITED IN THE TRANSPORTATION TRUST FUND, AND, UNLESS OTHERWISE PRESCRIBED BY THE AUTHORITY FROM WHICH SUCH MONEYS WERE RECEIVED, SHALL BE SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF ARTICLE 94A, § 11, OF THIS CODE. ALL EXPENDITURES OR DISBURSEMENTS BY THE ADMINISTRATION PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION ARE SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE SECRETARY OF TRANSPORTATION AS PROVIDED FOR IN ARTICLE 94A, § 11, OF THIS CODE.

(A) THE GOVERNING BODY OF ANY PUBLICLY OWNED AIRPORT IN THE STATE OF MARYLAND SHALL HAVE THE POWER AFTER HOLDING A PUBLIC HEARING TO ADOPT, AMEND AND ENFORCE RULES AND REGULATIONS RELATING TO THE PARKING OF MOTOR VEHICLES, THE MOVEMENT OF TRAFFIC, SAFETY AT THE AIRPORT, AND THE PRESERVATION OF ORDER WITH RESPECT TO THE AIRPORT. ANY PERSON WHO VIOLATES ANY RULE OR REGULATION ADOPTED PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION SHALL BE DEEMED GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR, AND UPON CONVICTION THEREOF IN A COURT OF THE JURISDICTION IN, WHICH THE AIRPORT IS LOCATED, SHALL BE FINED NOT MORE THAN ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00), OR IMPRISONED NOT MORE THAN THREE(3) MONTHS, OR BOTH; BUT IN NO EVENT SHALL ANY PERSON WHO VIOLATES A PARKING REGULATION ADOPTED PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION BE SUBJECTED TO A PENALTY OTHER THAN A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$15.00; AND PROVIDED FURTHER THAT ALL THE RULES AND REGULATIONS SHALL BE FIRST CONSPICUOUSLY POSTED IN A PUBLIC PLACE ON THE PREMISES.

(B) IN ALL CASES OF PARKING VIOLATIONS AT STATE OWNED AIRPORTS THE OFFICER WHO DISCOVERS THE VEHICLE ILLEGALLY PARKED, IN THE ABSENCE OF THE OPERATOR, SHALL ATTACH A SUMMONS TO THE VEHICLE IN A CONSPICUOUS PLACE OR IF THE OPERATOR BE PRESENT DELIVER THE SUMMONS TO HIM. A COPY OF THE SUMMONS SHALL BE RETAINED BY THE OFFICER AND SHALL BEAR CERTIFICATION UNDER PENALTY OF PERJURY BY THE OFFICER ATTESTING THE TRUTH OF THE MATTERS THEREIN SET FORTH. THE RECIPIENT OF A SUMMONS MAY WAIVE A HEARING BEFORE THE DISTRICT COURT FOR THE COUNTY IN WHICH THIS AIRPORT IS LOCATED IN THE MANNER SET FORTH ON THE SUMMONS. PROVIDED THAT IF THE PERSON SO SUMMONED DESIRES A HEARING HE MUST NOTIFY THE CLERK OF THE COURT OF HIS DESIRE IN THE MANNER SET FORTH ON THE SUMMONS. AT THE TIME THE NOTICE OF A DESIRE FOR A HEARING IS GIVEN, THE PERSON SUMMONED MUST ALSO GIVE NOTICE THAT HE DESIRES THE PRESENCE OF THE OFFICER WHO ISSUED THE SUMMONS AT THE
