CHAPTER 586

(Senate Bill 733)

AN ACT concerning

Washington Metropolitan Area Transit
Authority - Metro Transit Police

FOR the purpose of authorizing the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority to establish and maintain a regular police force; specifying the powers, duties, and jurisdiction of this police force; authorizing the Authority to adopt rules and regulations governing the use of its transit facilities; providing for penalties for violations of the Authority's rules and regulations; providing for the appointment, classification, training and compensation of the ~~[[member]]~~ members of the police force; authorizing the Authority to enter into mutual aid agreements with the various jurisdictions within the Transit Zone; defining the terms "transit zone" and "zone"; and generally relating to the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority and the Metro Transit Police.
