

FOR the purpose of correcting certain erroneous language which fails to distinguish between civilian and police employees of the Maryland State Police; providing that police employees of the Maryland State Police receive such salaries as provided in the State budget; requiring the Superintendent of the Maryland State Police[[to develop]] and the Secretary of Public Safety and Correctional Services to propose a salary plan for inclusion in the budget upon approval of the [[Secretary of Public Safety and Correctional Services]] Secretary of Personnel; and relating generally to salaries of police employees of the Maryland State Police.

Article 88B - State Police

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Sections 22(a) and 23 of Article 88B - State Police, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1969 Replacement Volume and 1973 Supplement) be and they are hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

Article 88B - State Police

22.

(a) From and after July 1, [1973] 1974, all POLICE employees of the Maryland State Police[, including police employees,] shall receive such salary, including any increment based upon length of service, [as is provided in § 23 of this article] AS SET FORTH IN A SALARY PLAN [[ADOPTED BY THE SUPERINTENDENT OF THE MARYLAND STATE POLICE AND APPROVED BY THE SECRETARY OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND CORRECTIONAL SERVICES]] PROPOSED BY THE SUPERINTENDENT OF MARYLAND STATE POLICE AND THE SECRETARY OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND CORRECTIONAL SERVICES AND APPROVED BY THE SECRETARY OF PERSONNEL ,AND PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.

f (a) Salaries as referred to in § 22 (a) shall be paid to police employees in accordance with rank and length of service at the following rates:
