

GLENARDEN

THE TERMS OF MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF ELECTIONS BEGIN ON THE FIRST MONDAY IN MARCH IN THE YEAR IN WHICH THEY ARE APPOINTED AND RUN FOR TWO YEARS. MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF ELECTIONS SHALL BE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF THE TOWN AND SHALL APPOINT ONE OF ITS MEMBERS AS SUPERVISOR OF THE BOARD, AND ANOTHER AS ASSISTANT SUPERVISOR OF THE BOARD OF ELECTIONS; THE OTHER EIGHT SHALL BE KNOWN AS JUDGES. NO MEMBER OF THE BOARD SHALL HOLD OR BE A CANDIDATE FOR ANY ELECTIVE OFFICE DURING HIS TERM OF OFFICE. VACANCIES ON THE BOARD SHALL BE FILLED BY THE MAYOR WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE COUNCIL FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE UNEXPIRED TERM. THE COMPENSATION OF THE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD SHALL BE DETERMINED BY THE COUNCIL.

22. (REMOVAL) ANY MEMBER OF THE BOARD OF ELECTIONS MAY BE REMOVED FOR GOOD CAUSE BY THE COUNCIL AND MAYOR. BEFORE REMOVAL, THE MEMBER OF THE BOARD OF ELECTIONS TO BE REMOVED SHALL BE GIVEN A WRITTEN COPY OF THE CHARGES AGAINST HIM AND SHALL HAVE A PUBLIC HEARING ON THEM BEFORE THE COUNCIL IF HE SO REQUESTS WITHIN TEN DAYS AFTER RECEIVING THE WRITTEN COPY OF THE CHARGES AGAINST HIM.

23. (DUTIES) THE BOARD OF ELECTIONS SHALL BE IN CHARGE OF THE REGISTRATION OF VOTERS, NOMINATIONS, AND ALL TOWN ELECTIONS, AND SHALL BE GOVERNED BY THE VOTER REGISTRATION AND ELECTION LAWS OF MARYLAND. THE BOARD MAY APPOINT ELECTION CLERKS OR OTHER EMPLOYEES TO ASSIST IT IN ANY OF ITS DUTIES, AND SHALL HOLD REGISTRATION PERIODS AT LEAST ON A QUARTERLY BASIS. THIS BOARD SHALL NOT CAUSE OR SEEK TO CAUSE ANY MEETINGS TO BE HELD FOR ANY CANDIDATE CAMPAIGN.

24. (NOTICE) THE BOARD OF ELECTIONS SHALL GIVE AT LEAST TWO WEEKS NOTICE OF EVERY REGISTRATION DAY AND EVERY ELECTION BY AN ADVERTISEMENT PUBLISHED IN THE NEWSPAPER OF GENERAL CIRCULATION WITHIN THE TOWN WHICH HAS BEEN PREVIOUSLY DESIGNATED BY THE COUNCIL FOR PUBLISHING OF ALL OFFICIAL AND LEGAL BUSINESS OF THE TOWN, AND BY POSTING A NOTICE THEREOF IN SOME PUBLIC PLACE OR PLACES IN THE TOWN.

25. (REGISTRATION) THERE SHALL BE A REGISTRATION AT LEAST QUARTERLY OF QUALIFIED PERSONS NOT REGISTERED TO VOTE. IF NECESSARY FOR THE PERFORMANCE OF REGISTRATION OR THE CONVENIENCE OF THE CITIZENS OF THE TOWN, THE MAYOR MAY DESIGNATE ADDITIONAL DAYS AS REGISTRATION DAYS. REGISTRATION SHALL BE PERMANENT, AND NO PERSON SHALL BE ENTITLED TO VOTE IN TOWN ELECTIONS UNLESS HE IS REGISTERED. IT SHALL BE THE DUTY OF THE BOARD OF ELECTIONS TO KEEP THE REGISTRATION LISTS UP TO DATE BY STRIKING FROM THE LISTS ANY PERSON WHO HAS NOT CAST ONE VOTE DURING THE PRECEDING FIVE YEAR PERIOD. PRIOR TO REMOVING SUCH PERSON'S NAME A NOTICE OF REMOVAL SHALL BE
