GRADUATION FROM A COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY OF RECOGNIZED STANDING PREFERABLY WITH MAJOR WORK IN ACCOUNTING; OR GRADUATION FROM A RECOGNIZED HIGH SCHOOL AND EIGHT (8) YEARS OF PROGRESSIVELY RESPONSIBLE EXPERIENCE IN ACCOUNTING OR BOOKKEEPING WORK; ONE (1) YEAR OF PUBLIC ACCOUNTING OR INTERNAL AUDITING EXPERIENCE MAY BE SUBSTITUTED FOR ONE (1) YEAR OF COLLEGE OR TWO (2) YEARS OF EXPERIENCE IN ACCOUNTING OR BOOKKEEPING WORK.

(47) AUDITOR, MANAGEMENT. GRADUATION FROM A COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY OF RECOGNIZED STANDING PREFERABLY WITH MAJOR WORK IN BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION; SIX (6) YEARS EXPERIENCE IN THE MAINTENANCE OF AND REPORTING UPON INTERNAL ADMINISTRATIVE CONTROLS; EACH ADDITIONAL TWO (2) YEARS IN EXCESS OF SIX (6) YEARS EXPERIENCE MAY BE SUBSTITUTED FOR ONE (1) YEAR OF COLLEGE UP TO A MAXIMUM OF TWO (2) YEARS.

(48) AUDITOR, PRINCIPAL. GRADUATION FROM A COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY OF RECOGNIZED STANDING PREFERABLY WITH MAJOR WORK IN ACCOUNTING; ELIGIBILITY FOR OR POSSESSION OF A CERTIFIED PUBLIC ACCOUNTANT'S CERTIFICATE IN THE STATE; FIVE (5) YEARS OF PUBLIC ACCOUNTING OR INTERNAL AUDITING EXPERIENCE INCLUDING ONE (1) YEAR IN A SUPERVISORY CAPACITY AND PREFERABLY SOME EXPERIENCE IN GOVERNMENTAL ACCOUNTING; POSSESSION OF A CPA CERTIFICATE IN THE STATE MAY BE SUBSTITUTED FOR TWO (2) YEARS OF COLLEGE.

(49) AUDITOR, SENIOR. GRADUATION FROM A COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY OF RECOGNIZED STANDING, PREFERABLY WITH MAJOR WORK IN ACCOUNTING; THREE (3) YEARS OF PUBLIC ACCOUNTING OR INTERNAL AUDITING EXPERIENCE OR SIX (6) YEARS OF PROGRESSIVELY RESPONSIBLE EXPERIENCE IN GOVERNMENTAL ACCOUNTING; EACH ADDITIONAL YEAR IN EXCESS OF THREE (3) YEARS OF PUBLIC ACCOUNTING OR INTERNAL AUDITING EXPERIENCE MAY BE SUBSTITUTED FOR ONE (1) YEAR OF COLLEGE UP TO A MAXIMUM OF TWO (2) YEARS.
