

COUNTY LOCAL LAWS

EQUIVALENT COMBINATION OF TRAINING AND EXPERIENCE. ELIGIBILITY FOR A MARYLAND MOTOR VEHICLE OPERATOR'S LICENSE.

(148) FIREFIGHTER II. GRADUATION FROM A RECOGNIZED HIGH SCHOOL AND ONE (1) YEAR OF PERTINENT SERVICE IN A FIRE DEPARTMENT; OR ANY EQUIVALENT COMBINATION OF TRAINING AND EXPERIENCE. ELIGIBILITY FOR A MARYLAND MOTOR VEHICLE OPERATOR'S LICENSE.

(149) FIREFIGHTER III. GRADUATION FROM A RECOGNIZED HIGH SCHOOL AND THREE (3) YEARS OF PERTINENT SERVICE IN A FIRE DEPARTMENT; OR ANY EQUIVALENT COMBINATION OF TRAINING AND EXPERIENCE. ELIGIBILITY FOR A MARYLAND MOTOR VEHICLE OPERATOR'S LICENSE.

(150) FIRE PROTECTION ENGINEER. SEE ENGINEER, FIRE PROTECTION.

(151) FOREMAN. GRADUATION FROM A RECOGNIZED HIGH SCHOOL AND THREE (3) YEARS OF EXPERIENCE IN CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE OF ROADS, WATER AND SEWER SYSTEMS OR RELATED FACILITIES, ONE (1) YEAR OF WHICH SHALL HAVE BEEN AT THE LEVEL OF CREW LEADER; OR ANY EQUIVALENT COMBINATION OF EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE.

(152) FOREMAN, BUILDING MAINTENANCE. GRADUATION FROM A RECOGNIZED HIGH SCHOOL; FOUR (4) YEARS OF JOURNEYMAN EXPERIENCE IN ONE (1) OR MORE OF THE BUILDING OR MECHANICAL TRADES AS RELATED TO BUILDING MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS; OR ANY EQUIVALENT COMBINATION OF EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE.

(153) GATEKEEPER AND SCALE MAN. GRADUATION FROM A RECOGNIZED HIGH SCHOOL AND THREE (3) YEARS OF RELATED WORK EXPERIENCE, PREFERABLY SOME EXPERIENCE IN CLERICAL WORK; OR ANY EQUIVALENT COMBINATION OF EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE.

(154) GENERAL CLERK. SEE CLERK, GENERAL.

(155) GOLF COURSE SUPERINTENDENT. SEE SUPERINTENDENT, GOLF COURSE.

(156) GREENSKEEPER. GRADUATION FROM A RECOGNIZED HIGH SCHOOL, PREFERABLY COMPLETION OF A COURSE IN TURF MANAGEMENT, THREE (3) YEARS OF EXPERIENCE IN GOLF COURSE MAINTENANCE, ONE (1) YEAR OF WHICH MUST HAVE BEEN IN THE MAINTENANCE OF TREES, TRAPS, AND GREENS; OR ANY EQUIVALENT COMBINATION OF EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE. POSSESSION OF A VALID MARYLAND MOTOR VEHICLE OPERATOR'S LICENSE.
