POSSESSION OF OR ELIGIBILITY FOR A MARYLAND STATE CERTIFIED INSPECTOR'S CERTIFICATE. POSSESSION OF A MARYLAND MOTOR VEHICLE OPERATOR'S LICENSE.

(159) INSPECTOR, BUILDING I. GRADUATION FROM A RECOGNIZED HIGH SCHOOL AND THREE (3) YEARS OF EXPERIENCE IN BUILDING CONSTRUCTION; OR ANY EQUIVALENT COMBINATION OF EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE.

(160) INSPECTOR, BUILDING II. GRADUATION FROM A RECOGNIZED HIGH SCHOOL AND FIVE (5) YEARS OF EXPERIENCE IN BUILDING INSPECTION OR BUILDING CONSTRUCTION; OR ANY EQUIVALENT COMBINATION OF EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE.

(161) INSPECTOR, COMBINATION. GRADUATION FROM A RECOGNIZED HIGH SCHOOL AND THREE (3) YEARS OF EXPERIENCE IN BUSINESS, INVESTIGATIONAL OR PUBLIC CONTACT WORK; OR ANY EQUIVALENT COMBINATION OF EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE.

(162) INSPECTOR, COMBINATION-SENIOR. GRADUATION FROM A RECOGNIZED HIGH SCHOOL AND FIVE (5) YEARS OF EXPERIENCE IN BUSINESS, INVESTIGATIONAL OR PUBLIC CONTACT WORK, ONE (1) YEAR OF WHICH MUST HAVE BEEN AT THE LEVEL OF COMBINATION INSPECTOR; OR ANY EQUIVALENT COMBINATION OF EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE.

(163) INSPECTOR, ELECTRICAL, CHIEF. GRADUATION FROM A RECOGNIZED HIGH SCHOOL, PREFERABLY COMPLETION OF A TWO (2) YEAR COMMUNITY OR JUNIOR COLLEGE PROGRAM OR TWO (2) YEARS OF COLLEGE TRAINING; SEVEN (7) YEARS OF EXPERIENCE AS A MASTER ELECTRICIAN OR AS AN ELECTRICAL INSPECTOR OF A PUBLIC OR PRIVATE INSPECTION AGENCY; PREFERABLY SOME ADMINISTRATIVE OR SUPERVISORY EXPERIENCE; AND POSSESSION OF A CURRENT MASTER ELECTRICIAN'S LICENSE FROM ANY POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND; OR ANY EQUIVALENT COMBINATION OF EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE. POSSESSION OF A MARYLAND MOTOR VEHICLE OPERATOR'S LICENSE.
