(259) PRINCIPAL ACCOUNT CLERK. SEE CLERK, ACCOUNT-PRINCIPAL.

(260) PRINCIPAL ACCOUNTANT. SEE ACCOUNTANT, PRINCIPAL.

(261) PRINCIPAL AUDITOR. SEE AUDITOR, PRINCIPAL.

(262) PRINCIPAL DRAFTSMAN. SEE DRAFTSMAN, PRINCIPAL.

(263) PRINCIPAL ENGINEER. SEE ENGINEER, PRINCIPAL.

(264) PRINCIPAL MANAGEMENT ANALYST. SEE ANALYST, MANAGEMENT-PRINCIPAL.

(265) PRINCIPAL PROGRAMMER. SEE PROGRAMMER, PRINCIPAL.

(266) PRINTER. CONSIDERABLE EXPERIENCE IN THE TECHNICAL PHASES OF JOB PRINTING WORK AND GRADUATION FROM A STANDARD HIGH SCHOOL; OR ANY EQUIVALENT COMBINATION.

(267) PROGRAM COORDINATOR. SEE COORDINATOR, PROGRAM.

(268) PROGRAMMER. GRADUATION FROM A UNIVERSITY OR COLLEGE OF RECOGNIZED STANDING, PREFERABLY WITH SPECIALIZATION IN BUSINESS OR PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION, ACCOUNTING, STATISTICS, MATHEMATICS, OR ENGINEERING; APTITUDE FOR PROGRAMMING IN THIRD GENERATION COMPUTER LANGUAGE(S); PREFERABLY ONE (1) YEAR OF EXPERIENCE IN PROGRAMMING IN THIRD GENERATION COMPUTER LANGUAGE(S); OR GRADUATION FROM A RECOGNIZED HIGH SCHOOL AND TWO (2) YEARS OF EXPERIENCE AT THE LEVEL OF ASSOCIATE PROGRAMMER, ONE (1) YEAR OF WHICH MUST HAVE BEEN IN PROGRAMMING IN THIRD GENERATION COMPUTER LANGUAGE(S); OR ANY EQUIVALENT COMBINATION OF EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE.

(269) PROGRAMMER, ASSOCIATE. GRADUATION FROM A RECOGNIZED HIGH SCHOOL; APTITUDE FOR PROGRAMMING IN ASSEMBLY LANGUAGE AND SOME EXPERIENCE IN DATA PROCESSING.

(270) PROGRAMMER, PRINCIPAL. GRADUATION FROM A UNIVERSITY OR COLLEGE OF RECOGNIZED STANDING, PREFERABLY WITH SPECIALIZATION IN BUSINESS OR PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION, ACCOUNTING, STATISTICS, MATHEMATICS, OR ENGINEERING; AND AT LEAST ONE (1) YEAR OF EXPERIENCE AT THE LEVEL OF SENIOR PROGRAMMER; OR GRADUATION FROM A RECOGNIZED HIGH SCHOOL AND TWO (2) YEARS OF EXPERIENCE AT THE LEVEL OF SENIOR PROGRAMMER IN THIRD GENERATION LANGUAGE(S); OR ANY EQUIVALENT COMBINATION OF EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE.
