

COUNTY LOCAL LAWS

HOWARD COUNTY, MARYLAND, that Section 12.212 be and the same is hereby added to Title 12 of the Howard County Code, title "Health and Social Services," subtitle "Board of Health," to read as follows:

12.212 MAINTENANCE OF PUBLIC TOILET FACILITIES IN GASOLINE SERVICE STATIONS.

(A) ALL GASOLINE SERVICE STATIONS IN HOWARD COUNTY, MARYLAND ARE REQUIRED TO FURNISH SEPARATE TOILET FACILITIES FOR MEN AND WOMEN. SAID TOILET FACILITIES SHALL BE ADEQUATE AND CONVENIENTLY LOCATED AND SHALL BE ACCESSIBLE TO THE PUBLIC DURING THE HOURS THE GASOLINE SERVICE STATION IS OPEN. TOILET FACILITIES SHALL BE INSTALLED IN ACCORDANCE WITH APPLICABLE STATE AND LOCAL LAWS, ORDINANCE, AND REGULATIONS. TOILET ROOMS SHALL BE COMPLETELY ENCLOSED, PROPERLY VENTILATED, AND SHALL HAVE TIGHT-FITTING, SELF-CLOSING DOORS. TOILET FACILITIES, INCLUDING THE TOILET ROOM AND FIXTURES, SHALL BE KEPT CLEAN AND IN GOOD REPAIR, AND FREE OF OBJECTIONABLE ODORS. THE COUNTY HEALTH OFFICER, SANITARIAN, OR HIS REPRESENTATIVE, SHALL, PURSUANT TO PROVISIONS FOR NOTICE AND HEARING SET FORTH IN SECTION 12.211 OF THIS SUBTITLE, ENFORCE THE MAINTENANCE OF SAID FACILITIES IN CLEAN AND SANITARY CONDITION SO AS NOT TO BE PREJUDICIAL TO HEALTH.

(B) FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION A "GASOLINE SERVICE STATION" IS ANY COMMERCIAL FACILITY WHICH DERIVES 50% OR MORE OF ITS GROSS INCOME FROM RETAIL SALES TO THE PUBLIC, ON THE PREMISES OF GASOLINE, MOTOR OIL AND LUBRICANTS (OR GREASE), MOTOR FUELS, MINOR AUTOMOBILE ACCESSORIES AND MINOR AUTOMOBILE SERVICING, MINOR REPAIRS AND MAINTENANCE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF HOWARD COUNTY, MARYLAND, that this Act shall take effect sixty (60) days after it stands enacted.

This Bill, having been approved by the Executive and returned to the Council, stands enacted on April 9, 1973.
