SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section 8-212(a) of Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1973 Volume) be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings
8-212.

(a) After the master jury wheel is emptied and refilled in accordance with §8-202(c) of this title, and after every person selected to serve as a juror before the master wheel was emptied has completed his service, all records and papers compiled and maintained by the jury commissioner or clerk before the master wheel was emptied shall be preserved in the custody of [[EITHER]] the clerk OR THE JURY COMMISSIONER for four years or for a longer period if ordered by the circuit court of a county.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1974.
