Article 32 - Dentistry  
 Section 35 to be under the new  
 subtitle "Reprimands and Probation"  
 Annotated Code of Maryland  
 (1971 Replacement Volume and 1973 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That new Section 35 to be under the new subtitle "Reprimands and Probation" be and it is hereby added to Article 32 - Dentistry, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1971 Replacement Volume and 1973 Supplement) to read as follows:

Article 32 - Dentistry

REPRIMANDS AND PROBATION

35.

IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROCEDURAL PROVISIONS CONTAINED IN THIS ARTICLE, THE BOARD MAY ISSUE A FORMAL REPRIMAND TO A DENTIST OR DENTAL HYGIENIST WHO VIOLATES A PROVISION OF THIS ARTICLE; OR IT MAY PLACE HIM OR HER "ON PROBATION" FOR A SPECIFICALLY DESIGNATED PERIOD OF TIME. AFTER THE EXPIRATION OF THE DESIGNATED TIME, THE PROBATIONARY STATUS SHALL BE REMOVED AUTOMATICALLY AND WITHOUT ANY FURTHER ACTION BEING REQUIRED BY THE BOARD, DENTIST, OR DENTAL HYGIENIST.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1974.
