

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety and having been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, the same shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 64

(Senate Bill 316)

AN ACT concerning

Dorchester County - Commissioners and Treasurer

FOR the purpose of amending certain laws and to repeal certain laws in the Code of Public Local Laws of Dorchester County relating generally to the powers, duties, operations, functions, salary, expenses, and surety bonds of the County Commissioners and County Treasurer, deputy treasurer, and the clerk to the county commissioners, eliminating obsolete, unnecessary, or duplicative laws and relating generally to these officials in the county government.
