

Classified Service under Article 64A of the Code and providing for their appointment therein.

BY adding to

Article 64A - Merit System  
Section 9K  
Annotated Code of Maryland  
(1972 Replacement Volume and 1973 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That new Section 9K be and it is hereby added to Article 64A - Merit System, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1972 Replacement Volume and 1973 Supplement) to read as follows:

Article 64A - Merit System

[[ON AND AFTER JULY 1, 1974, THE POSITIONS OF FIVE TERMINAL OPERATORS, ONE SUPERVISING TERMINAL OPERATOR, TWO PROOFREADERS, AND ONE SUPERVISING PROOFREADER IN THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF LEGISLATIVE REFERENCE ARE INCLUDED WITHIN THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE UNDER THIS ARTICLE. INITIAL APPOINTEES TO THESE POSITIONS SHALL BE PERSONS WHO HAVE SERVICE IN THEM FOR AT LEAST SIX MONTHS, AND THE APPOINTEES SHALL BE CONTINUED IN THEIR POSITIONS WITHOUT EXAMINATION OR FURTHER QUALIFYING REQUIREMENT. ]]

PERSONS EMPLOYED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF LEGISLATIVE REFERENCE FOR AT LEAST SIX CONSECUTIVE MONTHS IMMEDIATELY PRIOR TO JULY 1, 1974, ON A FULLTIME BASIS, PAID PER-DIEM SALARY, AND SERVING AS EITHER A TERMINAL OPERATOR, SUPERVISING TERMINAL OPERATOR, PROOFREADER OR SUPERVISING PROOFREADER SHALL BE ELIGIBLE FOR APPOINTMENT TO A COMPARABLE POSITION IN THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE UNDER THIS ARTICLE WITHOUT EXAMINATION OR FURTHER QUALIFYING REQUIREMENT.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1974.
