SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section 12-101 of Article 66 1/2 - Vehicle Laws, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1970 Replacement Volume and 1973 Supplement) be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

Article 66 1/2 - Vehicle Laws

12-101.

(a) It is a misdemeanor for any person to drive or move or for the owner to cause or knowingly permit to be driven or moved on any highway any vehicle or combination of vehicles which is in such unsafe condition as to endanger any person, or which does not contain those parts or is not at all times equipped with lamps and other equipment in proper condition and adjustment as required in this subtitle or which is equipped in any manner in violation of this subtitle, or for any person to do any act forbidden or fail to perform any act required under this subtitle.

(b) Nothing contained in this subtitle shall be construed to prohibit the use of additional parts and accessories on any vehicle not inconsistent with the provision of this subtitle.

(c) NO PERSON SHALL DISPLAY FOR SALE, SELL, OFFER FOR SALE, OR DELIVER FOR USE IN, UPON, OR AS A PART OF ANY MOTOR VEHICLE, TRAILER, SEMITRAILER, OR POLE TRAILER, ANY HEADLAMP, AUXILIARY OR FOG LAMP, REAR LAMP, WARNING LAMP, REFLECTOR, GLAZING MATERIAL, HYDRAULIC BRAKE FLUID, BRAKE LINING, ANTI-FREEZE, SEAT BELT, SHOULDER HARNESS OR SEAT BELT AND SHOULDER HARNESS ASSEMBLY, OR ANY OTHER ITEM OF EQUIPMENT OR DEVICE INCLUDING EYE PROTECTIVE DEVICES AND PROTECTIVE HELMETS, REQUIRED TO BE APPROVED BY THE ADMINISTRATOR UNLESS THE DEVICE IS OF A TYPE WHICH HAS BEEN SUBMITTED TO THE ADMINISTRATOR OR HIS AUTHORIZED AGENT AND HAS BEEN APPROVED BY HIM.
