## TITLE 5. OPENING THE ESTATE.

## SUBTITLE 1. GENERAL PROVISIONS.

## 5-101. SCOPE OF TITLE.

## (A) APPLICATION.

THIS SUBTITLE IS APPLICABLE TO THE PORTION OF THE PROBATE PROCEEDING WHICH RELATES TO THE PROBATE OF A WILL, IF ANY, AND THE GRANT OF LETTERS.

## (B) PROBATE OF A WILL AND GRANT OF LETTERS.

PROBATE OF A WILL, IF ANY, AND THE GRANT OF LETTERS, MAY BE ACCOMPLISHED AFTER FILING OF A PETITION FOR PROBATE BY:

(1) ADMINISTRATIVE PROBATE BY THE REGISTER OF WILLS AS DESCRIBED IN SUBTITLE 3; OR

(2) JUDICIAL PROBATE BY THE COURT AS DESCRIBED IN SUBTITLE 4.
