

(a) The Superintendent of the Maryland State Police shall conduct an investigation into the character, reputation and qualifications of the person named in the application. The investigation shall be carried out under the rules and regulations prescribed by the Superintendent AND SHALL INCLUDE AN INVESTIGATION [[INTO]] REGARDING THE APPLICANT'S [[PAST]] CRIMINAL RECORD, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO CHECKING RECORDS OF LOCAL POLICE DEPARTMENTS AND THE FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION. The results of the investigation shall be transmitted to the Governor with a recommendation as to the denial or granting of the application and the reasons therefor. The Governor may accept the recommendation as submitted but is under no obligation to issue a commission approved by the Superintendent if he believes it not in the best interest of the State to do so. [[THE GOVERNOR SHALL NOT ISSUE A COMMISSION TO ANY PERSON WHO HAS BEEN CONVICTED OF A FELONY AND BEEN INCARCERATED IN ANY PENAL INSTITUTION IN THE STATE OF MARYLAND.]]

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1974.

CHAPTER 206

(House Bill 307)

AN ACT concerning

State Board of Dental Examiners - Vacancies

FOR the purpose of requiring that the Governor fill vacancies on the State Board of Dental Examiners from a list of qualified dentists jointly submitted to him by the Maryland State Dental Association and the Maryland Dental Society; and relating generally to the filling of vacancies on the State Board of Dental Examiners; and clarifying the language.
