

Section 4-801(d) and 4-809[[(b)]] (d)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section 4-809(b) of Article - Natural Resources, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1973 Volume) be and it is hereby repealed~~[[[:]]~~ and re-enacting, with amendments, to read as follows:

Article - Natural Resources

4-809.

[(b) Fat crabs, snot crabs, green crabs, and buckram crabs.— A person may not catch, possess, or keep in floats any fat crabs, or any crab known as snot crab, green crab, or buckram crab.]

(b) IN THE WATERS OF WORCESTER COUNTY, [[A]] A person may not catch, possess, or keep in floats any fat crabs, or any crab known as snot crab, green crab, or buckram crab.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 4-801(d) of Article - Natural Resources, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1973 Volume) be and it is hereby renumbered to be Section 4-801(e).

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That new Sections 4-801(d) and 4-809[[(b)]] (d) be and they are hereby added to Article - Natural Resources, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1973 Volume) to read as follows:

4-801.

(D) "GREEN CRAB" MEANS AN UNDER-DEVELOPED PEELER.

4-809.

[[(B)]] (D) GREEN CRABS AND BUCKRAM CRABS.— A PERSON MAY NOT CATCH, POSSESS, OR KEEP IN FLOATS ANY GREEN CRAB WHICH IS LESS THAN FIVE INCHES FROM TIP TO TIP OF THE SPIKES, OR ANY BUCKRAM CRAB OF ANY SIZE.
