

obstruction when stopping, standing, or parking would obstruct traffic;

(vii) Upon any bridge or other elevated structure upon a highway or within a highway tunnel;

(viii) At any place an official sign prohibits stopping;

(ix) On any ramp entering on or exiting from, any highway with two or more traffic lanes moving the same direction;

(x) On any property owned by the Board of Education of Montgomery County or Montgomery College where an official sign prohibits such parking[.];

(xi) ON ANY PROPERTY OWNED BY THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF BALTIMORE COUNTY AND THE COMMUNITY COLLEGES OF BALTIMORE COUNTY WHERE AN OFFICIAL SIGN PROHIBITS THAT PARKING.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1974.
