

BY repealing and re-enacting, with amendments,

The Public Local Laws of Somerset County
Section 13, 15, 146, 266, 313, 317, 318,
325, and 326
Article 20 - Public Local Laws of Maryland
(1963 Edition and 1967 Supplement)

WHEREAS, As an integral part of its responsibility, Governor Mandel in 1970 charged the Governor's Commission to Revise the Annotated Code to study and make recommendations concerning related problems in the public local laws which may be perceived during the course of Code Commission Activities. In conjunction with the in-depth research on the Courts Article, related material in the public local laws of Somerset County was discovered which is in conflict with current provisions of the law and in adopted style; now, therefore,

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Sections 2 and 3 of the Public Local Laws of Somerset County being Article 20 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1963 Edition and 1967 Supplement, as added amended by Chapter — of the Acts of 19—.) be and they are hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Sections 13, 15, 146, 266, 313, 317, 318, 325, and 326 of the Public Local Laws of Somerset County being Article 20 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1963 Edition and 1967 Supplement) be and they are hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

Article 20

13.

The board of county commissioners shall provide for the immediate payment of jurors and State's witnesses in attendance [upon said] IN THE court. The payment shall be made by the treasurer of [said] THE board upon presentation and endorsement of the certificate of [such] THE attendance issued by the clerk of the Circuit Court for Somerset County to each of [such] THE jurors and witnesses presenting [the same] A CERTIFICATE. In order to procure the money necessary to put the county treasury on [such] A cash basis the board of county commissioners may borrow a sum of money not exceeding [six thousand dollars] \$6,000 [in amount] and pay interest on the [same] LOAN not exceeding [five per centum] 5 PERCENT per annum and issue county bonds [therefor] for sums of not
