came into Court and acknowledged himself indebted to the right  
honourable the Lord Proprietary in the sum of ten thousand  
pounds of Tobacco to be made levyed on his body goods and  
chattels lands and tenements to the use of the said Lord ship his  
heirs and assigns conditionally that if he shall not make his  
personal appearance at the next Court to be held for Kent County on  
the third Tuesday in November next ensuing then and there  
to answer unto a certain information for not reading the Act of  
assembly against Swearers & Sabbath breakers &c. whereunto  
he acknowledges himself to be content

His Lordship The same William at last June Court had  
taken Kent County entered into recognizance  
with surety for his appearance at this Court  
and in the mean time he is to be of good  
behaviour &c.  
William Graves

and was here at this Court to wit at Kent County at the Court house  
in the Town of Chester in said County on the third Tuesday in Aug.  
being the twentieth day of said Month Anno Domini 1791  
seven hundred and thirty four came the said William Graves  
and in his proper person appeared and prayed that his recognizance  
and his surety recognizance for his appearance may be  
ordered by this Court here to wit the same day and year last  
mentioned that the same recognizance and surety be discharged  
as prayed

William Graves of his recognizance taken as aforesaid in the sum of

The above is ordered by the Court

His Lordship The same William is ordered by this  
Court to enter into recognizance for his  
appearance at next November Court  
with surety and good behaviour &c.  
Whereupon William Graves of Kent County
