his Bailwaite & her wife keepers that you have her body before the  
Justice of our West County Court to be held at our Court house in the Town  
of Chester in said County on the third Tuesday of March next to answer  
unto a certain presentment for selling of Liquor contrary to an  
Act of Assembly made & provided in such cases &c.

And that the said Sheriff have at the time & place aforesaid presentment  
&c. All which said third Tuesday of March being the sixteenth day  
of said month in the year of our Lord Seventeen hundred thirty & five  
cometh William Harris Esq<sup>r</sup> Sheriff of West County and made return  
thereof to the Court here thereon Endowed as folo Viz<sup>t</sup>

late of St Pauls Parish in the County aforesaid the wife of Benjamin  
Butler
