(E) THIS SUBTITLE SHALL NOT APPLY TO THE CONSTRUCTION OF AN ELECTRIC GENERATING STATION OR AN OVERHEAD TRANSMISSION LINE OR LINES DESIGNED TO CARRY A VOLTAGE IN EXCESS OF 69,000 VOLTS.

(F) THIS SUBTITLE SHALL NOT AFFECT ANY PERMITS ISSUED OR APPLIED FOR PRIOR TO ITS EFFECTIVE DATE.

67. FEDERAL REQUIREMENTS

(A) IF ANY PART OF THIS SUBTITLE IS FOUND TO BE IN CONFLICT WITH FEDERAL REQUIREMENTS WHICH ARE A CONDITION TO THE GRANT OF FEDERAL FUNDS TO A LOCAL GOVERNMENT, TO THE STATE, OR TO ANY AGENCY OF THE STATE, THE PART IN CONFLICT IS DECLARED TO BE INOPERATIVE TO THE LIMITED EXTENT OF THE CONFLICT AND WITH RESPECT TO THE AGENCIES DIRECTLY AFFECTED BY IT.

(B) TO THE LIMITED EXTENT NECESSARY TO COMPLY WITH CONFLICTING FEDERAL REQUIREMENTS, THE LOCAL GOVERNMENTS AND STATE AGENCIES MAY MODIFY THE NOTICE, TIMING, HEARING AND RELATED PROCEDURAL MATTERS PROVIDED IN THIS SUBTITLE.

(C) TO THE LIMITED EXTENT NECESSARY TO COMPLY WITH FEDERAL REQUIREMENTS, WHERE A PERMIT IS ISSUED JOINTLY BY A STATE AGENCY AND THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT, THE STATE AGENCY MAY MODIFY THE NOTICE, TIMING, HEARING AND RELATED PROCEDURAL MATTERS PROVIDED IN THIS SUBTITLE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1975.
