

RETAIN THE SUM OF 10 CENTS AS COMPENSATION FOR ISSUING EACH STAMP. THE BALANCE OF THE FEE SHALL BE PAID OVER AND ACCOUNTED FOR IN THE SAME MANNER AS HUNTERS LICENSES.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1975.

CHAPTER 647

(House Bill 120)

AN ACT concerning

State Roads - Highway Beautification

FOR the purpose of authorizing the State Highway Administration to promulgate rules and regulations governing the control and use of rest areas, scenic overlooks, roadside picnic areas and other public use areas within interstate or other state highway rights-of-way and correcting language.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section 237 of Article 89B - State Roads, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1969 Replacement Volume and 1974 Supplement) be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

Article 89B - State Roads

237.

(A) The State [Roads Commission is hereby authorized to] HIGHWAY ADMINISTRATION MAY acquire strips of land necessary, in the opinion of the [Commission,] ADMINISTRATION, for the restoration, preservation and enhancement of scenic beauty within and adjacent to federal-aid highways of this State, including acquisition
