

COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT BETWEEN A LABOR ORGANIZATION, AS DEFINED IN 29 U.S.C. §152 (5), AND AN EMPLOYER OR GROUP OF EMPLOYERS, WHICH CONTAINS THOSE LABOR OBJECTIVES;

(2) ANY INCORPORATED OR UNINCORPORATED AGRICULTURAL OR HORTICULTURAL COOPERATIVE ORGANIZATION OR ITS INDIVIDUAL MEMBERS DIRECTED SOLELY TO THEIR LAWFUL OBJECTIVES;

(3) A PUBLIC SERVICE COMPANY, AS DEFINED IN THE MARYLAND PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION LAW, OR A RATING ORGANIZATION OR BUREAU REPRESENTING THE COMPANY, TO THE EXTENT THAT THE ACTIVITY IS SUBJECT TO THE JURISDICTION OF THE PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION OR AUTHORIZED BY FEDERAL LAW GOVERNING INTERSTATE COMMERCE;

(4) AN INSURER, INSURANCE AGENT, INSURANCE BROKER, PUBLIC ADJUSTER, INSURANCE ADVISOR, OR RATING ORGANIZATION, TO THE EXTENT THAT THE ACTIVITY IS SUBJECT TO REGULATION BY THE COMMISSIONER OF INSURANCE OF THE STATE OR IS AUTHORIZED BY THE INSURANCE CODE OR ANY OTHER LAW OF THE STATE, INCLUDING THE MAKING OF OR PARTICIPATING IN JOINT UNDERWRITING OR JOINT REINSURANCE ARRANGEMENTS;

(5) A NONPROFIT CORPORATION, TRUST, OR ORGANIZATION ESTABLISHED EXCLUSIVELY FOR RELIGIOUS OR CHARITABLE PURPOSES, OR FOR BOTH PURPOSES, TO THE EXTENT THAT THE ACTIVITY IS A RELIGIOUS OR CHARITABLE ACTIVITY;

(6) A SECURITY DEALER WHO IS LICENSED BY THE STATE OR WHO IS A MEMBER OF THE NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF SECURITIES DEALERS OR A MEMBER OF A NATIONAL SECURITIES EXCHANGE REGISTERED WITH THE SECURITIES AND EXCHANGE COMMISSION UNDER THE SECURITIES EXCHANGE ACT OF 1934, IN THE COURSE OF HIS BUSINESS OF OFFERING, SELLING, BUYING AND SELLING, OR OTHERWISE TRADING IN OR UNDERWRITING SECURITIES AS AN AGENT, BROKER, OR PRINCIPAL, OR THE ACTIVITY OF A REGISTERED NATIONAL SECURITIES EXCHANGE, INCLUDING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF COMMISSION RATES AND SCHEDULES OF CHARGES;

(7) A BOARD OF TRADE DESIGNATED AS A "CONTRACT MARKET" BY THE SECRETARY OF AGRICULTURE OF THE UNITED STATES UNDER 9 U.S.C. §5;

(8) ANY PERSON TO THE EXTENT THAT THE ACTIVITY IS SUBJECT TO THE JURISDICTION OF THE METROPOLITAN TRANSIT AUTHORITY OR THE WASHINGTON METROPOLITAN AREA TRANSIT AUTHORITY;

(9) A STATE OR NATIONAL BANK TO THE EXTENT THAT THE ACTIVITY IS REGULATED OR SUPERVISED UNDER THE BANKING
