

approves. Employees of the Board shall be selected in accordance with the rules of the State Department of Personnel. Each appointed miner and operator member receives \$12 for each day of service rendered as a Board member. He shall be reimbursed for necessary traveling expenses and disbursements made in the conduct of his official duties IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE STANDARD TRAVEL REGULATIONS, not to exceed \$200 in any year.

SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1975.

CHAPTER 714

(House Bill 781)

AN ACT concerning

State Agencies - Reimbursement for Expenses
