

EQUAL TO THE RESERVES REQUIRED TO FUND THE ADDITIONAL ALLOWANCE FOR THOSE YEARS OF FEDERAL, OUT-OF-STATE MUNICIPAL SERVICE, OR A COMBINATION OF BOTH, AS HE MAY CLAIM. THE MEMBER MAY PAY FOR THE RESERVES ON AN INSTALLMENT BASIS BY CONTRIBUTING NOT LESS THAN 5 PERCENT A YEAR. THE APPROPRIATE FINAL ADJUSTMENTS SHALL BE MADE IN THE YEAR IN WHICH THE MEMBER RETIRES.

CHAPTER 772

(House Bill 1190)

AN ACT concerning

Merit System - State Employees' Pay Plan

FOR the purpose of providing that amendments to the pay plan may be made from time to time for specific classes of positions when recommended by the Secretary of Personnel and approved by the Governor and presented to the General Assembly on or before a certain date; generally relating to the amendments and clarifying language.
