

(E) CERTIFICATES OF [[CANDIDATES, EXCEPT FOR NOMINATION OF MEMBERS OF CONGRESS OR FOR CANDIDATES FOR OFFICES TO BE FILLED BY THE VOTERS OF THE ENTIRE STATE,]] CANDIDACY FOR THE [[NOMINATION OF MEMBERS OF THE STATE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF DELEGATES, AND FOR]] CANDIDATES FOR ELECTION AS DELEGATES TO A NATIONAL CONVENTION, MAY BE FILED BY CERTIFIED MAIL, RETURN RECEIPT REQUESTED, [[RECEIVED NO LATER THAN SEVEN DAYS BEFORE THE FILING DEADLINE, TO THE STATE ADMINISTRATIVE BOARD OF ELECTION LAWS]] WITH THE STATE ADMINISTRATIVE BOARD OF ELECTION LAWS, AND IF MAILED, MUST BE RECEIVED BY THE STATE BOARD NO LATER THAN 15 DAYS BEFORE THE FILING DEADLINE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1975.

CHAPTER 784

(House Bill 1321)

AN ACT concerning

Cecil County - Record of Expenses

FOR the purpose of requiring the County Commissioners of Cecil County to publish all records of County expenses in their minutes and make them available for public inspection at a certain time; [[requiring that bills be available for inspection in the Treasurer's Office;]] making provisions generally relating to records of expenses in Cecil County; and clarifying language.
