SUBTITLE 3. DOOR-TO-DOOR SALES.

14-301. DEFINITIONS.

(A) IN GENERAL.

IN THIS SUBTITLE THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection is new language used as the standard introductory language to a definition section.

(B) BUSINESS DAY.

"BUSINESS DAY" MEANS ANY CALENDAR DAY EXCEPT SUNDAY OR THE FOLLOWING BUSINESS HOLIDAYS: NEW YEAR'S DAY, WASHINGTON'S BIRTHDAY, MEMORIAL DAY, INDEPENDENCE DAY, LABOR DAY, COLUMBUS DAY, VETERANS' DAY, THANKSGIVING DAY, AND CHRISTMAS DAY.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection presently appears as Art. 83, §28(g).

The Commission notes that the "business holidays" listed in this subsection differ somewhat from legal holidays generally recognized in the State; for comparison, see Art. 13, §9 of the Code.

(C) CONSUMER GOODS AND SERVICES.

"CONSUMER GOODS" AND "CONSUMER SERVICES" MEAN:

(1) GOODS OR SERVICES PURCHASED, LEASED, OR RENTED PRIMARILY FOR PERSONAL, FAMILY, OR HOUSEHOLD PURPOSES; AND

(2) COURSES OF INSTRUCTION OR TRAINING, REGARDLESS OF THE PURPOSE FOR WHICH THEY ARE TAKEN.

(D) DOOR-TO-DOOR SALE.

(1) "DOOR-TO-DOOR SALE" MEANS A SALE, LEASE, OR RENTAL OF CONSUMER GOODS OR CONSUMER SERVICES UNDER
