

Such Captains, Commanders, Lieutenants, Master officers, Seaman Soldiers or other persons so offending shall be left to be
 proceeded ag^t and tryed as the merit of their offences shall require either by Commission under the great Seals of
 England as by Statute of Henry the eighth Direct or by Commission from the said Commissioners for
 executing the office of high Admirall of England or from the high Admirall for the time being according to the
 force of an act of Parliament passed in the Thirtieth Year of the Reign of y^e late King Charles the Second and
 not otherwise saving only that it shall and may be lawfull for you upon any such Captain and Commander
 refusing or neglecting to execute or upon his negligent or unadvised Execution of any of the written orders he shall
 receive from you for our Service and the Service of the said Province to suspend him the said Captain or Command^r
 from the Exercise of his said Office of Captain or Commander and to commit him into Close Custody either on
 Board his said Ship or elsewhere at your Discretion in order to his being brought to answer for the Crime by
 Commission under the Great Seals of England or from y^e said Commission^r for executing the Office of high Admirall
 or from the high Admirall for the time being as is before expressed in which Case our Will and Pleasure is that
 the Captain or Commander by you so suspended shall during such his Suspension and Commitment be succeeded in his said
 Office by such Commission or Warrant Officer of the said Ships appointed by y^e said Commission^r for executing the Office
 of high Admirall of England or by the high Admirall of England for the time being as by the known practice and
 Discipline of our habit doers ought to succeed him as in Cases of Death Sickness or other ordinary Disability happening
 to our Command^r in Chief or any of our said Ships of Warre and notwithstanding you abiding alwaies accomplished to us for
 the Truth and Importancie of the Crimes and misdemeanours for which you shall see good to the suspending of
 such Captain or Commander provided also that all Disorders and misdemeanours committed or should be by any Captains
 Commanders Lieutenants Master or other Officers Seaman Soldiers or other persons whatsoever belonging to any of our Ships
 of Warre or other vessels acting by Immediate Commission or Warrant from y^e Commission^r for executing the
 Office of high Admirall of England under y^e Seals of the Admiralty or from y^e high Admirall of England for y^e
 time being may be tryed and punished according to the Law of the place where any such Disorders offences and
 misdemeanours shall be so committed on Shoar notwithstanding such Offender be in actual Service and bound in
 our Bay on board any such our vessels of Warre or other vessels acting by Immediate Commission or Warrant
 from the Commissioners for executing the Office of high Admirall or from the high Admirall as aforesaid
 doo as he shall not receive any Protection for the avoiding of Justice or for such Offender committed on Shoar
 from any persons of his being employd in any Service at Sea And we doo hereby give you full power by
 authority to appoint fairs marks and markes as also such and so many Light Houses Bays houses and
 other places for the Conduency and Security of Shipping and for the better Loading and Unloading of Goods
 and Merchandizes as by you wth the Advice and Consent of y^e said Council shall be thought fitt and necessary
 and in them or any of them to erect houses and appoint Custom houses Warehouses and offices relating
 therunto and them to alter change or Displace from time to time as wth the Advice aforesaid shall be
 thought fitt and our further Will and Pleasure is that you shall not at any time hereafter
 by Virtue of any power or authority hereby granted or mentioned to be granted take upon you to give Grant
 or Dispose of any place or Office within the said Province or Territory of Maryland which now are reserved
 under y^e Great Seals of England any further then that you may upon the Vacancy of any such Office or Place or
 Suspension of any such Officer by you put in any person to officiate in the Interval till the same be disposed
 of by us our heirs and Successors under the Great Seals of England or that our further Directions be given therein
 And we doo further by these presents will require and Command you to take all possible Care for y^e
 Discourtening of vice and Incongruities of vice and good Living that by such Example the Indians
 may be invited and desired to partake of the Christian Religion and we doo hereby require and Command all officers
 and
