or the Heir or Heirs of John Weaver Esq. of the City  
of Bristol and Assigns of Mary Ann and her Heir  
and Assigns of Money goods wares Merchandise Efforts  
and Demands whatsoever and shall be any way due  
owing or becoming unto me or to me and my Company or  
of the said Ship from the said John Weaver or his Heir or  
Assigns by virtue of two Brevets Bills of Exchange bearing  
Date their said April the 14th 1705 Drawn by the said John  
Weaver on the said John Fullworth in West Street in Bristol the  
one being for Fifty pounds and the other for one hundred pounds  
payable to me and my Company Brevets of the said Bills being  
the said Bills having been provided the said Bills  
of August 1705 for non payment on the thirteenth Day of  
September 1705 for non payment or upon or by virtue of the  
said Brevets or either of them or by any other ways or means  
whatsoever being and by these presents granting unto my said  
Attorney my said Right full power and lawful Authority
