Bay Sloop called the Free Mason, now in the Possession of the  
said Daniel Hull, of the Burthen of Thirty Tons or there abouts  
with all her Sails, Rigging, Tackel, Furniture and Apparell  
To have and To hold the said Vessel with the Appurtenances  
to the said Trustees their Executors, Administrators, and Assigns  
for ever. And the said Daniel Hull for himself his Heirs
