THERE IS ESTABLISHED IN THIS STATE A SYSTEM OF RECIPROCITY FOR LICENSING BETWEEN ALL ELECTRICAL BOARDS, WHETHER THEY BE STATE, MUNICIPAL, OR LOCALLY APPOINTED BOARDS.

321.

THE SYSTEM OF RECIPROCITY SHALL CONTAIN THE FOLLOWING AGREEMENTS:

(A) A RECIPROCAL ELECTRICAL LICENSE OF THE SAME CLASS OR FOR THE SAME TYPE OF WORK PERFORMED, IF AVAILABLE, SHALL BE ISSUED BY ALL ELECTRICAL BOARDS WITHIN THE STATE, WITHOUT EXAMINATION, TO ANY ELIGIBLE APPLICANT WHO HAS OBTAINED HIS LICENSE BY AN EXAMINATION IN A JURISDICTION WITHIN THIS STATE AND WHO HAS HELD A LICENSE IN THAT JURISDICTION FOR A PERIOD OF AT LEAST ONE YEAR IMMEDIATELY PRIOR TO APPLYING. A LICENSEE WHOSE PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS IS LEGALLY ESTABLISHED IN THIS STATE OR WHO IS A RESIDENT OF THIS STATE IS ELIGIBLE UNDER THE RECIPROCITY SYSTEM. RECIPROCITY SHALL BE GRANTED THE LICENSEE TO OBTAIN ONLY THE INITIAL RECIPROCAL LICENSE IN ANY OTHER JURISDICTION. A LICENSEE WHOSE LICENSE IS SUSPENDED OR REVOKED OR WHO HAS A RECORD OF VIOLATIONS OF THE REGULATIONS IN ANY ONE JURISDICTION WITHIN THIS STATE, AT THE TIME OF APPLYING, MAY NOT BE ELIGIBLE UNDER THE RECIPROCITY SYSTEM. THE ELECTRICAL BOARD OF THE JURISDICTION WHERE AN APPLICANT WAS LICENSED BY EXAMINATION, SHALL FURNISH IN WRITTEN FORM THE FOLLOWING BASIC INFORMATION:

(1) DATE THE APPLICANT WAS ISSUED ELECTRICAL LICENSE BY EXAMINATION; AND

(2) VERIFICATION THAT THE APPLICANT HAS NO CURRENT RECORD OF VIOLATIONS OF REGULATIONS OR SUSPENSION OF LICENSE.

(B) A RECIPROCAL ELECTRICAL LICENSE OF THE SAME CLASS OR FOR THE SAME TYPE OF WORK PERFORMED, IF AVAILABLE, SHALL BE ISSUED BY ALL ELECTRICAL BOARDS WITHIN THE STATE, WITHOUT EXAMINATION, TO ANY ELIGIBLE APPLICANT WHO HAS OBTAINED HIS LICENSE WITHOUT AN EXAMINATION, IN A JURISDICTION WITHIN THIS STATE, AND WHO HAS HELD A LICENSE IN THAT JURISDICTION FOR A PERIOD OF TWO YEARS IMMEDIATELY PRIOR TO APPLYING AND PROVIDED ALL OTHER REQUIREMENTS SET FORTH IN THIS ACT ARE MET. ALL EXISTING LICENSE HOLDERS AS OF JULY 1, 1976, ARE ELIGIBLE FOR IMMEDIATE RECIPROCITY.

(C) UNDER THE RECIPROCITY SYSTEM AN ELECTRICAL LICENSE FOR THE SAME TYPE OF WORK PERFORMED SHALL BE ISSUED BY ALL ELECTRICAL BOARDS WITHIN THE STATE, WITHOUT EXAMINATION AND UPON FURNISHING OF REQUIRED EVIDENCE, TO ANY ELIGIBLE APPLICANT WHO HAS HAD AN ESTABLISHED ELECTRICAL BUSINESS IN A NONLICENSED SUBDIVISION OF THIS
