CHAPTER 392

(House Bill 574)

AN ACT concerning

Unemployment Insurance Law - Extended Unemployment

FOR the purpose of extending the waiver of the 120 percent requirement for triggering on or off a State period of extended unemployment insurance benefits until a certain date.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section 21(h) of Article 95A - Unemployment Insurance Law, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1969 Replacement Volume and 1975 Supplement) be and it is hereby repealed and reenacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

Article 95A - Unemployment Insurance Law

(h) With respect to compensation for weeks of
