

(4) WASTEWATER COLLECTION, TREATMENT AND DISPOSAL FACILITIES AND PROJECTS;

(5) SOLID WASTE COLLECTION, RECYCLING AND DISPOSAL FACILITIES AND PROJECTS;

(6) STORM DRAINAGE, EROSION AND SEDIMENT CONTROL FACILITIES AND PROJECTS;

(7) LIGHTING FOR ROADS, HIGHWAYS, ALLEYS AND OTHER PUBLIC PLACES;

(8) FIRE HYDRANTS, MOSQUITO CONTROL FACILITIES AND PROGRAMS AND SNOW AND ICE REMOVAL;

(9) WHATEVER OTHER FUNCTIONS AND DUTIES WHICH ARE NOT INCONSISTENT WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION AND ARE ASSIGNED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS.

(C) AN ORDINANCE OR RESOLUTION CREATING A DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS SHALL PROVIDE FOR THE RETIRING, REPUNING, REFINANCING, TRANSFER, OR ASSUMPTION OF ANY EXISTING APPLICABLE OUTSTANDING BONDED INDEBTEDNESS OF THE COUNTY AUTHORITY, DISTRICT OR COMMISSION WHICH PRECEDED IT.

(D) THE POWERS GRANTED TO COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MAY BE EXERCISED NOTWITHSTANDING THE EXISTENCE OF ANY PUBLIC GENERAL LAW OR PUBLIC LOCAL LAW TO THE CONTRARY WHICH IS IN EXISTENCE AT THE TIME THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS EXERCISE THE POWER GRANTED BY THIS SECTION.
