

writing and must be signed by both the warden or superintendent and by the Commissioner of Correction, and this authority may not be delegated. As a condition of granting such leave, the Commissioner may require the inmate's agreement to waive his right to contest extradition proceedings. All such orders must be kept on file in the Department. Special leave may only be for the purpose of:

- [(a)] (1) Attending educational programs.
- [(b)] (2) Improving job skills.
- [(c)] (3) Attending trade licensing examinations.
- [(d)] (4) Being interviewed for employment.
- [(e)] (5) Participating as a volunteer for a governmental agency in an activity serving the general public.
- [(f)] (6) Participating in athletic competition.
- [(g)] (7) Participating in civic activities beneficial to the inmate and/or the community.

(B) THE WARDEN OF THE BALTIMORE CITY JAIL HAS THE SAME LEAVE AUTHORITY WITH RESPECT TO INMATES OF THE BALTIMORE CITY JAIL THAT THE COMMISSIONER OF CORRECTION HAS UNDER THIS SECTION WITH RESPECT TO INMATES UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTION, AND THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION APPLY TO SPECIAL PROGRAMS OR ACTIVITIES LEAVE FOR INMATES OF THE JAIL, EXCEPT THAT "WARDEN" MEANS DEPUTY WARDEN IN RELATION TO THE JAIL. REFERENCE TO THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTION IN THIS SECTION MEANS THE BALTIMORE CITY JAIL IN RELATION TO THE JAIL.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1976.

(House Bill 1300)

AN ACT concerning

Frederick County - Tax Sales

FOR the purpose of correcting certain obsolete and inconsistent sections relating to tax sales in Frederick County.
