(e) In Baltimore County, real and tangible personal property owned by the Gunpowder Youth Camps, Inc., when used exclusively as a nonprofit youth camp AND REAL PROPERTY OWNED BY [[A NONPROFIT COMMUNITY OR CIVIC IMPROVEMENT ASSOCIATION OR CORPORATION, WHICH IS DEVOTED TO AND USED EXCLUSIVELY FOR COMMUNITY, CIVIC, EDUCATIONAL, OR LIBRARY PURPOSES, AND WHERE SUCH USE IS NOT CONTINGENT UPON THE PAYMENT OF ANY FEE OR OTHER COMPENSATION, AND FAILURE TO PAY ANY FEE OR OTHER COMPENSATION IS NOT A REASON TO DENY ADMISSION TO OR USE OF THIS PROPERTY. ASSESSMENTS EXACTED AND EMPLOYED BY THE ASSOCIATION OR CORPORATION SOLELY FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OR MAINTENANCE OF THE PROPERTY ARE NOT "FEES OR OTHER COMPENSATION" UNDER THE TERMS OF THIS PARAGRAPH.]] THE HARFORD PARK IMPROVEMENT ASSOCIATION OF BALTIMORE COUNTY, INC.
