21-1209. THROWING OBJECT AT BICYCLIST; OPENING DOOR OF MOTOR VEHICLE.

A PERSON MAY NOT:

(1) THROW ANY OBJECT AT OR IN THE DIRECTION OF ANY PERSON RIDING A BICYCLE; OR

(2) OPEN THE DOOR OF ANY MOTOR VEHICLE WITH INTENT TO STRIKE, INJURE, OR INTERFERE WITH ANY PERSON RIDING A BICYCLE.

21-1210. COPIES OR SUMMARIES OF LAWS AND REGULATIONS.

THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL PUBLISH COPIES OR SUMMARIES OF THE REGULATIONS AND LAWS OF THIS STATE THAT REGULATE THE OPERATION OF BICYCLES AND MAKE THEM AVAILABLE, ON REQUEST AND WITHOUT COST, TO EVERY DEALER ENGAGED IN THE RETAIL SALE OF BICYCLES IN THIS STATE. THESE DEALERS SHALL PROVIDE A COPY TO EACH PERSON WHO BUYS A BICYCLE.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section presently appears as Art. 66 1/2, §11-1208.

The present provision that the copies or summaries be made available "at cost" is deleted as obsolete and substituted with the phrase "without cost"; to avoid inordinate administrative expenses, the Administration currently distributes these free of charge. Since dealers no longer need to pay for the publication, the present exception for dealers in Garrett and Allegany counties likewise is deleted as obsolete.

SUBTITLE 13. OPERATION OF MOTORCYCLES.

21-1301. TRAFFIC LAWS APPLY TO PERSONS OPERATING MOTORCYCLES.

EVERY PERSON OPERATING A MOTORCYCLE HAS ALL THE RIGHTS GRANTED TO AND IS SUBJECT TO ALL THE DUTIES REQUIRED OF THE DRIVER OF ANY OTHER VEHICLE UNDER THIS TITLE, EXCEPT:
