

CONDITIONS STATED IN SUBSECTION (A) ANY MOTOR VEHICLE USED TO CARRY EXPLOSIVES, ANY CARGO TANK TRUCK USED TO CARRY FLAMMABLE LIQUIDS OR COMPRESSED GASES, OR ANY MOTOR VEHICLE USING COMPRESSED GAS AS A FUEL, UNLESS THERE IS CARRIED IN THE VEHICLE THREE RED ELECTRIC LANTERNS OR THREE PORTABLE RED EMERGENCY REFLECTORS MEETING THE REQUIREMENTS OF SUBSECTIONS (A) AND (C) OF THIS SECTION, AND THERE MAY NOT BE CARRIED IN THE VEHICLE ANY FLARES, FUSEES, OR SIGNAL PRODUCED BY FLAME.

(C) APPROVAL OF EQUIPMENT BY ADMINISTRATOR; PORTABLE REFLECTOR WARNING DEVICES TO CONFORM TO FEDERAL STANDARDS.

(1) NO FLARE, FUSEE, ELECTRIC LANTERN, WARNING DEVICE, OR WARNING FLAG MAY BE USED TO COMPLY WITH THIS SECTION UNLESS THE EQUIPMENT IS OF A TYPE THAT HAS BEEN SUBMITTED TO AND APPROVED BY THE ADMINISTRATOR.

(2) AFTER JUNE 30, 1974, NO PORTABLE REFLECTOR WARNING DEVICE MAY BE USED TO EQUIP A VEHICLE THAT IS REQUIRED BY THIS SECTION TO BE SO EQUIPPED UNLESS IT MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS SPECIFIED IN THE APPLICABLE FEDERAL MOTOR VEHICLE SAFETY STANDARDS. VEHICLES EQUIPPED WITH PORTABLE REFLECTOR DEVICES BEFORE JULY 1, 1974, MAY CONTINUE TO USE A DEVICE CONFORMING TO THE REQUIREMENTS OF A TYPE 2 DEVICE AS SPECIFIED IN THE SOCIETY OF AUTOMOTIVE ENGINEERS RECOMMENDED STANDARDS UNTIL SUCH TIME AS THE DEVICE IS REPLACED. REPLACEMENT DEVICES SHALL CONFORM TO THE APPLICABLE FEDERAL STANDARDS.

22-408. DISPLAY OF WARNING DEVICES WHEN VEHICLE DISABLED.

(A) PLACING OF REFLECTORS, LIGHTS, ETC., GENERALLY.

WHENEVER ANY TRUCK, PASSENGER BUS, TRUCK TRACTOR, TRAILER, SEMITRAILER, OR POLE TRAILER, OR ANY MOTOR VEHICLE TOWING A MOBILE HOME IS DISABLED ON THE ROADWAY OR SHOULDER OF ANY HIGHWAY OUTSIDE OF ANY MUNICIPAL CORPORATION AT ANY TIME WHEN LIGHTED LAMPS ARE REQUIRED ON VEHICLES, THE DRIVER OF THE VEHICLE SHALL DISPLAY THE FOLLOWING WARNING DEVICES ON THE HIGHWAY DURING THE TIME THE VEHICLE IS SO DISABLED ON THE HIGHWAY, EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (B), (C) OR (E) OF THIS SECTION.

(1) A LIGHTED FUSEE, A LIGHTED RED ELECTRIC LANTERN, OR A PORTABLE RED EMERGENCY REFLECTOR SHALL BE
