

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That new Section 25(d-2) be and it is hereby added to Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1976 Replacement Volume and 1976 Supplement) to read as follows:

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

25.

(D-2) IN KENT COUNTY, A SPECIAL CLASS C BEER AND WINE LICENSE AND A SPECIAL CLASS C BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR LICENSE MAY BE ISSUED TO ANY bona fide RELIGIOUS, FRATERNAL, CIVIC, VETERANS', HOSPITAL, OR CHARITABLE CLUB, SOCIETY, ASSOCIATION, OR ORGANIZATION, FOR A PERIOD NOT EXCEEDING ONE DAY. THE FEE FOR THE SPECIAL BEER AND WINE LICENSE IS \$5 \$15, AND THE FEE FOR THE SPECIAL BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR LICENSE IS ~~\$45~~ \$25.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1977.
