SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1977.

AN ACT concerning

Overweight Vehicles - Permits

FOR the purpose of altering certain permit fees charged by the State Highway Administration for overweight vehicles using State highways.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section 24-112 (b) of Article - Transportation, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (As enacted by Chapter _____ of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1977) be and it is hereby repealed and reenacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

Article - Transportation

24-112.

(b) (1) The State Highway Administration may issue a permit allowing an overweight vehicle to use the highways in this State.

(2) For each permit issued under this subsection, the State Highway Administration shall charge a fee of:

(i) \$15 for the first 45 tons (90,000 pounds) or less of gross weight of the vehicle; and
